ABOUT GOLD COAST RAINBOW COMMUNITIES AND GOLD COAST PRIDE Gold Coast Rainbow Communities is the leading organisation for gay, lesbian and gender diverse people on the Gold Coast. Gold Coast Rainbow Communities began in 2020, rising from the ashes of Covid, and we've held a number of events to very positive responses from our community since then. We are called both GCRC and Gold Coast Pride.

We believe in the value and validity of same-sex attracted people, and we celebrate and embrace diversity and inclusion across our LGBTIQ+ communities on the Gold Coast.

Our work revolves around meeting the needs of our communities through advocacy, education, counselling and support, and acting as a point of contact for LGBTIQ social connection and wellbeing.

We hold regular events for our community, ranging from club events, drag queen trivia and bingo, picnics, bushwalks, tennis and swimming events, and our flagship event, an annual Pride festival.

## ABOUT GOLD COAST PRIDE FESTIVAL 2021 SUNDAY 30 MAY, KIRRA BEACH

Launching at 11am. LGBTIQA+ people will be skydiving and landing on the beach where their partner will be waiting. Once landed, the partner will propose and then they make their way up to the festival area.

Other members of the LGBTIQA+ community will also skydive, raising the profile of gender-diverse people on the Gold Coast with an exhilarating demonstration of the Festival theme of "blue sky thinking". This will be a major media event that highlights the beauty, inclusiveness and liveability of the unique place that is the Gold Coast.

the Festival will feature market stalls, food trucks, a bar area, community

stalls and DJs on the main stage. The DJs will be spinning a curated selection of contemporary dance anthems and "blasts from the past" with lots of family-friendly disco hits from the 1970s and 1980s.

There will be roving circus performers, a free jumping castle and activities for the kids. Gender-questioning, gender-diverse and transgender teens will be supported with a designated space featuring bean bags, decorations and soft drinks.



## GOLD COAST PRIDE FESTIVAL -MISS GOLD COAST DRAG QUEEN PAGEANT





The highlight of the day will be the first Miss Gold Coast competition, a beauty pageant featuring professional drag queens and transgender people, who will compete across three categories (gown, beach and social) for the title. Judging the Drag Queen Beauty pageant will be legendary drag queens Dame Liz Taylor and Trixie Onassis who in 2018 was inducted into the Queensland Drag Hall of Fame. Prizes donated from our sponsors include a stay for two in a Port Douglas resort, a tiara, styled wigs and make-up kits. The Drag Queen runway walks will be interspersed with drag queen performances by the glamorous host and MC, Miss Carmen Taykett and supported by leading Gold Coast drag queens Cookie Cartell and Roxy Harte.

Overall, the Pride Festival will cultivate a safe, festive and culturally sensitive atmosphere for the Gold Coast LGBTIQA+ community to feel included in, and to enjoy.






## **GENDER FLUID PICNIC**

DJ Sammy is from the Gold Coast music scene and catching the eye of some of the industry's biggest names.

Sammy had an ear for music from an early age, and he recalls the moment he heard Klass' – "Where's Your Head At" as first sparking the passion that would come to fuel his DJ career. He purchased his first set of decks as a youngster and began to teach himself and perfect his art. In 2010, Sammy performed to his first crowd at MP's Nightclub on the Gold Coast, securing a weekly residency within two months.

Fast forward and a little over 5 years later and his experimentation and self-taught skills have allowed Sammy to claim his place on major dancefloors all across the country, playing Family Nightclub, The Beat Megaclub, The Wickham Hotel, and Element Nightclub in Brisbane; through to Sin City and Escape Bar & Club on the Gold Coast; and down to ARQ,

Stonewall Hotel, The Midnight Shift and The Imperial Hotel in Sydney ... & everywhere in between.

A mainstay of The Sydney Mardi Gras, & Brisbane Big Gay Day Main stage, and favourite of Ski Week New Zealand, DJ Sammy is no stranger to the festival crowds.

The dancefloor becomes body-hugging when Sammy enters the booth, playing big room, electro house, house, the latest anthems, and anything with that deep, satisfying, gay bass. This DJ knows exactly how to drive a crowd into a frenzy! It's no surprise that he's earned a growing army of ardent fans.
